



The east and the deep south of Madagascar in 9 days

Wildlife highlights of the National park in Andasibe rainforest, and the private reserve of Berenty.

Dates: 5 – 13August 2019

Minimum pax: 2pax Maximum pax : 14pax

Day 1: Antananarivo - Andasibe

Morning drive to the eastern part of Madagascar, to reach Andasibe or Perinet.

After about 4 hours drive with stop on the way, arrive at destination by lunch time. Have an afternoon visit of the private park of Vakona where the wildlife expedition starts: spot lemurs, birds, crocodiles etc...followed by an evening walk to spot night active wildlife.

Overnight at HOTEL EULOPHIELA on half board





Day 2: Andasibe

After breakfast, full day visit at Mantadia National Park. The park is an extraordinary animal diversity with many species: mammals, birds (many of them endemic), reptiles, among them the biggest chameleon of the island, leaf-tailed geckos, and amphibians... Late in the afternoon return to the Lodge, then go on for another evening walk along the road at Andasibe to spot night active wildlife.

Overnight at HOTEL EULOPHIELA on half board





> Day 3: Andasibe - Antananarivo

After breakfast, enjoy another morning expedition; walk into the special reserve of Analamazaotra. This part of the forest, is famous for its population of *Indri lemurs* which are the largest living lemurs and endemics, and others species of fauna and flora. After lunch, drive back in Antananarivo and check –in at the hotel.



Day 4: Antananarivo - Fort Dauphin

Morning transfer to the airport and fly to Fort Dauphin in the south east of Madagascar. At arrival, go for a wildlife expedition in the reserve of Nahampoana, a very interesting botanical garden situated at 7km from the town, composed by a typical vegetation of the east and the south which exists only around the area of Fort Dauphin. After the visit, transfer to the hotel.

Overnight at HOTEL LE DAUPHIN on half board



Day 5: Fort Dauphin - Berenty

After breakfast, drive to the Berenty private reserve. Upon arrival, Check in to your lodge then go for an evening walk to spot night active wildlife.

Overnight at **BERENTY LODGE** on half board





> Day 6 and 7: Berenty

You will have the opportunity to explore the private reserve. Berenty is a small private reserve set in the semi arid spiny forest. The reserve is home to six species of lemurs and the south's largest colony of Madagascar fruit bats. Morning walk in the reserve to spot lemurs, bird, etc.. with a visit at the museum which allow you to learn about the life of the local tribe, the Antandroy. Then visit the gallery forest of Berenty which contains a collection of the extraordinary flora of the spiny forest, followed by an evening walk to spot night active wildlife.

Overnight at **BERENTY LODGE** on half board





Day 8: Berenty - Fort Dauphin

Today, drive back to Fort Dauphin, then upon arrival have the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at CROIX DU SUD on half board





Day 9: Fort Dauphin - Antananarivo

Today, after breakfast, transfer to the airport to take flight back to Antananarivo. After that, transfer to your hotel in Antananarivo.
